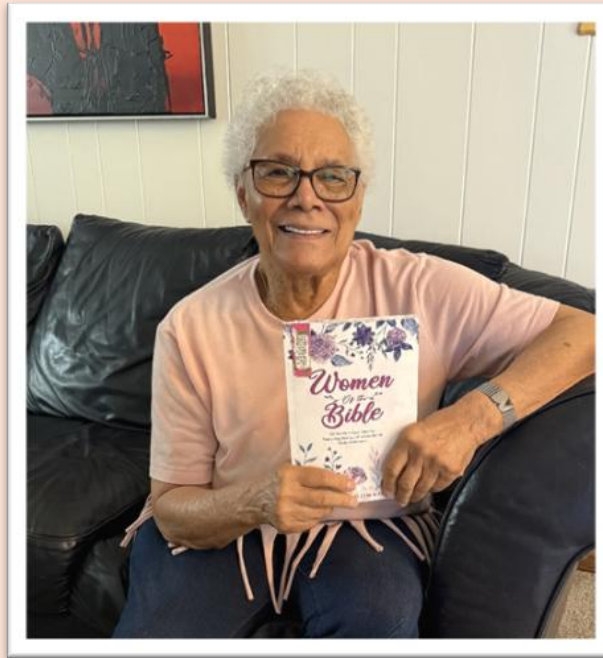

We are excited to announce that St. Cyprian's will offer two worship services on Sundays, beginning in May 2025. The Rev. Dr. Hector Sintim will be the Celebrant and offer communion at both the 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. services. The worship service at 8 a.m. will not be streamed.



Baptism and Confirmation

Those who wish to be baptized are requested to submit your names to the priest by **Sunday, May 11, 2025**. Baptism will take place on **Sunday, July 27, 2025** during the 10 a.m. worship service. You may secure an application for Holy Baptism from the parish administrator.

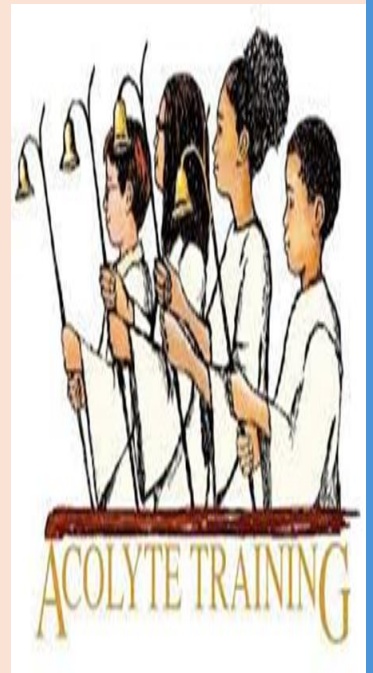
Safe Church Policy and Annual Audit

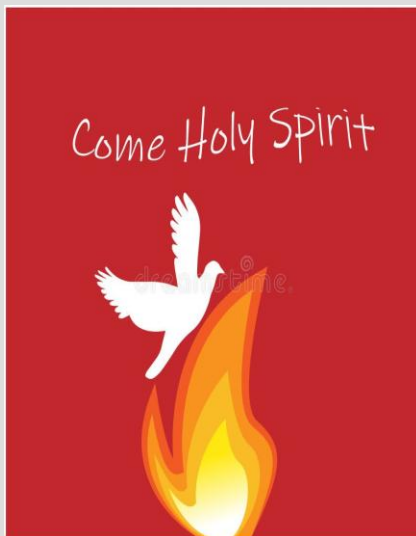
Calling All Children for Acolyte Rehearsal June 7, 2025 at 4 p.m.

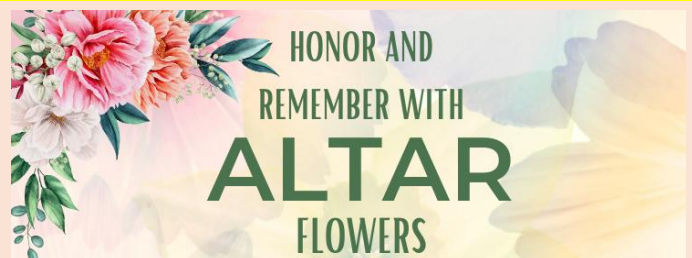

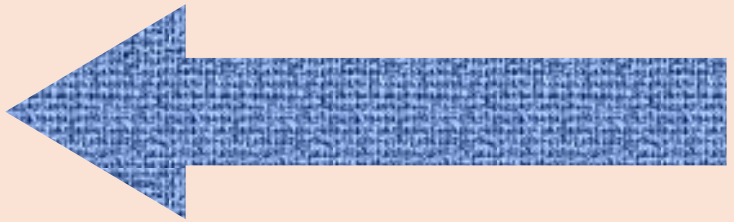

Certificate of Lay Delegates and Alternate

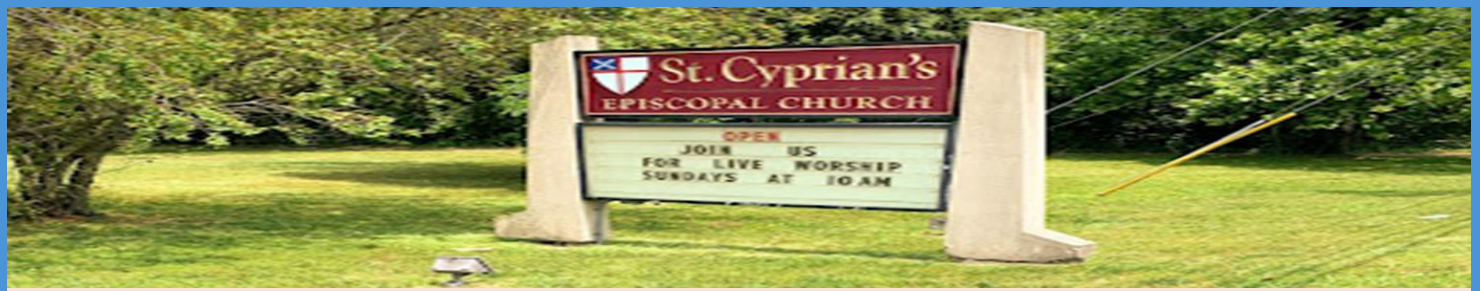
