The Rev. Dr. Sintim is pictured holding a pencil to symbolize oneness. A pencil appears to stand alone, but its multiple parts make it strong and serviceable. On Sunday, June 1, 2025, the Rev. Sintim preached on “Ubuntu,” an African word meaning, “I am because we are.” He further explained that Jesus faced many challenges throughout his life, yet he consistently demonstrated a commitment to uplifting and encouraging others. Rev. Sintim stressed that “we should put all of our resources together so we can be one.”

NOMINATIONS NOW OPEN

CERTIFICATE OF LAY DELEGATES AND ALTERNATE

Churches must submit a Certificate of Lay Delegates and Alternates to register for the Annual Council. Certificates are due by **October 1, 2025** to the diocesan office. Two delegates and one alternate will be nominated by the Vestry to serve for a period of one year, beginning January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026. This term includes eligibility to vote at Pre-Council Convocation meetings, Annual Council in February, and any other Special Council or other called meetings that may occur during this period. 
EARL HESTER

Juneteenth is observed on June 19 each year commemorating the emancipation of the enslaved African Americans back in 1865. President Joe Biden signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act into law on June 17, 2021.

President Abraham Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation outlawing slavery in the original confederate states on January 1, 1863. On June 19, 1865, the Union Army General Gordon Granger, under the General Order No. 3, enforced the freedom of enslaved people in the last held out state in the confederacy, Texas.
